

MANTI BOY KILLED IN TWELVE-MILE

Was Son of Mr. and Mrs. John
Metcalf and Well Known
In Carbon County.

Vernon Metcalf, the 18-year-old son of Mr and Mrs John Metcalf of Manti, was killed instantly, last Saturday while bringing a load of lumber down Twelve-Mile Canyon, which is situated just east of Mayfield. He had been working for the past month with Silas Hofheims, hauling poles and lumber from Henningson's saw-mill. On this trip he was accompanied by Leland Hofheims, a son. While going down a very steep hill, Leland pulled so hard that the rope on the brake lever was broken. He told Vernon to jump and then immediately leaped off the wagon. In his scramble to regain his footing he could not tell whether Vernon had jumped or had been knocked off, but when he came to a position where he could see what had happened, he was astonished to find him lying dead by the roadside with his head crushed.
